Etow has served CPS over the past 10 years as COO, and has more than 30 years of clinical pharmacy practice and hospital pharmacy management experience. CPS is the nation’s leading pharmacy services provider, serving acute care and specialty hospitals, medical centers and healthcare facilities (over 260 facilities in 48 states and the Caribbean) for more than 38 years. CPS employs 1,600+ pharmacy professional employees.

In 2008 CPS completed the acquisition of McKesson Medication Management from McKesson Corporation, further augmenting CPS’ aggressive growth and establishing the company as the nation’s largest pharmacy services provider. A year later in 2009, CPS expanded again with it’s announcement of entering the remote pharmacy services / order entry business by acquiring Naperville, Illinois – based, RxKnights Corporation. The acquisition enabled CPS to offer clients after-hours remote order entry, giving smaller hospitals a high quality and affordable option for safely providing pharmacy services on a 24/7 basis. With escalating operational costs and a national pharmacist shortage, these hospitals are seeking ways to maintain a premium level of patient care and compliance with The Joint Commission, CMS and HIPPA standards.

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
